

RANGE RULES

BE SURE TO READ THE RANGE RULES THOROUGHLY

- SAFETY IS ALWAYS TOP PRIORITY - SHOOTERS OF MAUMEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE BUSINESS TO ANYONE AT ANYTIME FOR ANY REASON
- SHOOTERS OF MAUMEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INSPECT ALL FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION
- VIEWING OF THE SAFETY VIDEO AND SIGNING OF A HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT IS A REQUIREMENT BEFORE EVERY VISIT
- ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN
- DO NOT ENTER THE RANGE IF YOU ARE PREGNANT OR NURSING
- FOOD, DRINKS AND TOBACCO ARE *NOT* PERMITTED INSIDE THE RANGE
- THE USE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS *BEFORE OR DURING* SHOOTING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED AND WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE PROPERTY
- ALL GUNS MUST BE UNLOADED WITH THE ACTION OPENED AND CARRIED IN A CASE OR BOX UNTIL ON THE FIRING LINE EXCEPT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND CCW PERSONNEL
- EYE AND EAR PROTECTION ARE MANDATORY AND MUST BE PUT ON *BEFORE* ENTERING THE RANGE
- ONLY AMMUNITION PURCHASED THROUGH SHOOTERS OF MAUMEE CAN BE FIRED THROUGH THE RENTAL FIREARMS
- WHEN ENTERING AND EXITING THE RANGE WAIT FOR ONE DOOR TO CLOSE BEFORE OPENING THE SECOND DOOR
- TWO PEOPLE PER LANE ARE PERMITTED INSIDE THE RANGE - ADDITIONAL GUESTS MUST WAIT IN THE SHOW ROOM AND VIEWING AREA
- TREAT EVERY GUN AS IF IT WAS LOADED
- ALIGN YOUR TARGET SO YOU DO NOT SHOOT THE CEILING, FLOOR, OR OTHER TARGETS
- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR GUN UNLOADED UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO USE IT
- BEFORE HANDLING ANY GUN BE SURE IT IS POINTED DOWN RANGE
- KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOU ARE ON TARGET AND READY TO SHOOT
- ASK FOR HELP IF YOU ARE UNFAMILIAR WITH THE OPERATION OF ANY GUN
- ONLY ONE GUN MAY BE FIRED PER LANE AT ANY TIME - NO HOLSTER OR QUICK DRAW FIRING ALLOWED
- NEVER LEAVE A LOADED GUN SITTING ON THE BENCH BY ITSELF - IN THE EVENT OF A JAMMED OR MALFUNCTIONING FIREARM, LAY THE FIREARM ON THE BENCH POINTING DOWN RANGE AND RAISE YOUR HAND FOR ASSISTANCE.
- WHEN RELOADING KEEP YOUR GUN POINTED DOWN RANGE AND PARALLEL TO THE FLOOR
- WHEN YOU WANT TO TAKE A PAUSE BETWEEN SHOOTING TAKE YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER, POINT THE MUZZLE DOWN RANGE AND REST YOUR ELBOWS AT YOUR HIPS
- WHEN CHANGING SHOOTERS OR CHECKING TARGETS THE GUN MUST BE UNLOADED AND LAYING ON THE BENCH POINTED DOWN RANGE
- *NEVER* HAND A LOADED GUN TO ANYONE FOR ANY REASON
- NEVER CROSS THE FIRING LINE FOR *ANY* REASON - ALL BODY PARTS MUST REMAIN BEHIND THE FIRING LINE AT ALL TIMES
- WHEN YOU HEAR "CEASE-FIRE!" TAKE YOU FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER, KEEP GUN POINTED DOWN RANGE WITH ELBOWS ON YOUR HIPS AND WAIT FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE RANGE OFFICER
- ANYONE CAN AND SHOULD CALL "CEASE-FIRE!" DURING DANGEROUS SITUATIONS
- ALWAYS WASH YOUR HANDS WHEN YOU ARE DONE SHOOTING AND HANDLING GUN
- **SHOOTERS OF MAUMEE REQUIRES CUSTOMERS WISHING TO USE FIREARMS REGULATED BY THE NFA (RE: CLASS 3, SOT) PROVIDE COPIES OF OWNERSHIP AND LICENSING TO BE HELD BY STAFF DURING THEIR VISIT**

Hold Harmless Agreement and Limits of Liability

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

In no event shall the management of Shooters of Maumee, its shareholders, officers, heirs, consigns, and/or employees be held responsible or liable for acts or omissions, for any indirect, direct, incidental, special or consequential damage or costs whatsoever resulting from or related to the use or misuse of firearms on any of the shooting range facilities.

Shooters of Maumee officials have taken every precaution to ensure user safety during your visit to the facility and shall not be held liable for any act or omission outside its jurisdiction and control or directly related to negligence on the part of a customer.

Steps taken by Shooters of Maumee include the training of range officers, field operators, and management staff. Customers of this facility have been notified of range/safety rules.

Customer expressly agrees to hold Shooters of Maumee harmless for any acts or omissions on their part as it relates to:

- Transportation of firearms to and from the facility and to certify that the method used to transport said firearms conforms to the laws of the State of Ohio.
- Handling of firearms.
- Use of firearms while participating in live-fire events on any of the ranges.

Customer affirms that they are knowledgeable of the firearms and ammunition they will use while visiting the range and that they have received, read, understand, and will comply with posted and published rules and regulations as it relates to the use of said facilities, and/or that they have been informed that basic firearms education courses are available to any user who is unfamiliar with shooting as a recreational activity. Further, that failure to comply could result in their expulsion from the range and receive temporary and/or permanent loss of range privileges.

Customer expressly understands that Shooters of Maumee management reserves the right to refuse access to any person(s) for any reason that might result in a safety violation, damage to the facilities, or who becomes a safety hazard, i.e., they demonstrate unsafe firearm handling practices, a lack of proper training, their use of an unsafe firearm, they become loud, boisterous or disruptive, or any other act or omission that is contrary to established criteria, for operating a safe and efficient shooting range.

Customer affirms, by their signature, that they **have refrained from being under the influence of alcoholic beverages or drugs while on property** owned and/or controlled by Shooters of Maumee. Further, customer affirms they understand that the consumption of drugs or alcoholic beverages is expressly prohibited on the Shooters of Maumee property, and that any person(s) who, strictly by our observations, appear to be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs or emotionally unstable, shall be denied access to any part of the facility.

Customer does hereby affirm that they alone shall assume full responsibility for their own actions while visiting the Shooters of Maumee facility and that any injury sustained either be their act or omission directly attributed to the lack of training, or careless acts shall be borne by them.

Customer does hereby affirm that the ammunition they will use in their firearm(s) has been properly loaded, either by a licensed manufacturer or if the ammunition has been hand-loaded by themselves that it was done so by following established criteria as contained in leading reloading manuals; and further, that said reloads meet or exceed factory specifications regarding safety. Further, that Customer understands that they **MAY NOT USE ARMOR PIERCING, STEEL CORE, INCENDIARY, OR TRACER AMMUNITION** and that if they do, any damages resulting from such use may be billed directly to them; i.e., damage to range structures or fires.

CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THEY WILL BE CHARGED full replacement fees for damaging shooting stalls, floors, walls, ceiling baffles, or target carriers. The amount will be determined by the severity of damage. If customer feels that they cannot abide by this regulation, Shooters of Maumee suggests they take a firearms handling class to better prepare themselves for their experience at Shooters of Maumee. Customer acknowledges that if for any reason, they should intentionally use unsafe firearms practices to inflict body injury or death to themselves or others, their family as well as estate heirs will be held liable.

By your signature you certify that you have read, understand, and will comply with the requirements as set forth herein, and do hereby agree to hold Shooters of Maumee its shareholders, officers, managers, assigns, heirs, or employees harmless from any act or omission for which you are directly responsible.
